

## Market Performance

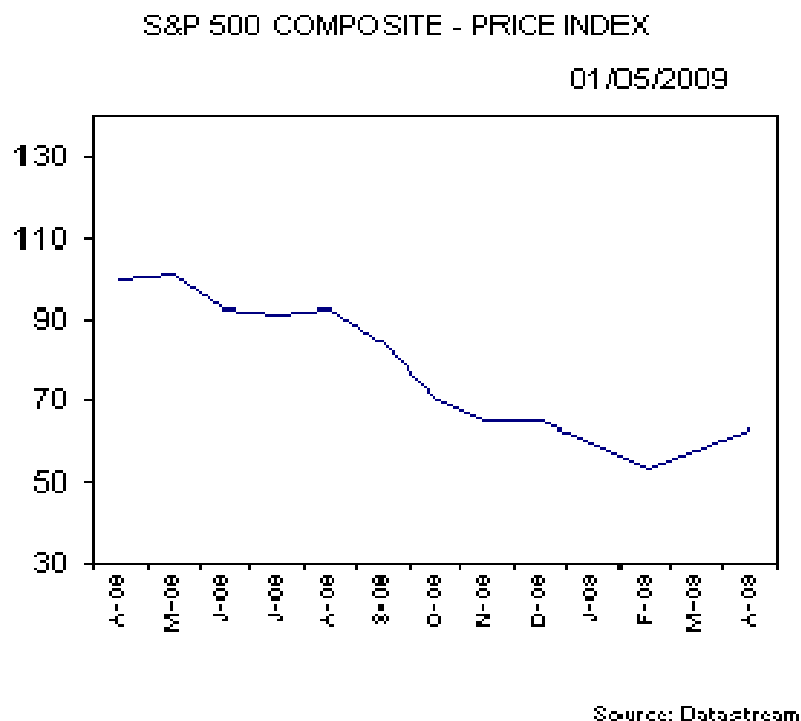
**Past performance is not a reliable indicator of future result.** Below you can find the market performance charts for the world's major regions.

The charts show the market performance over five years (in local currency of the respective areas), as well as over one year to the date indicated on the graphs. (Figures are rebased to 100).

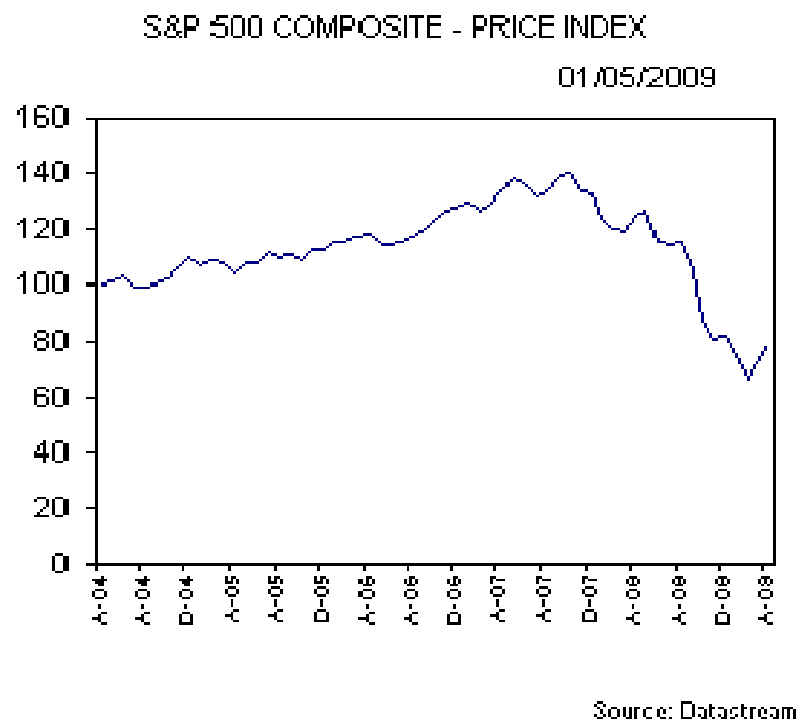
### Market Performance: United States

#### 12 Month Performance



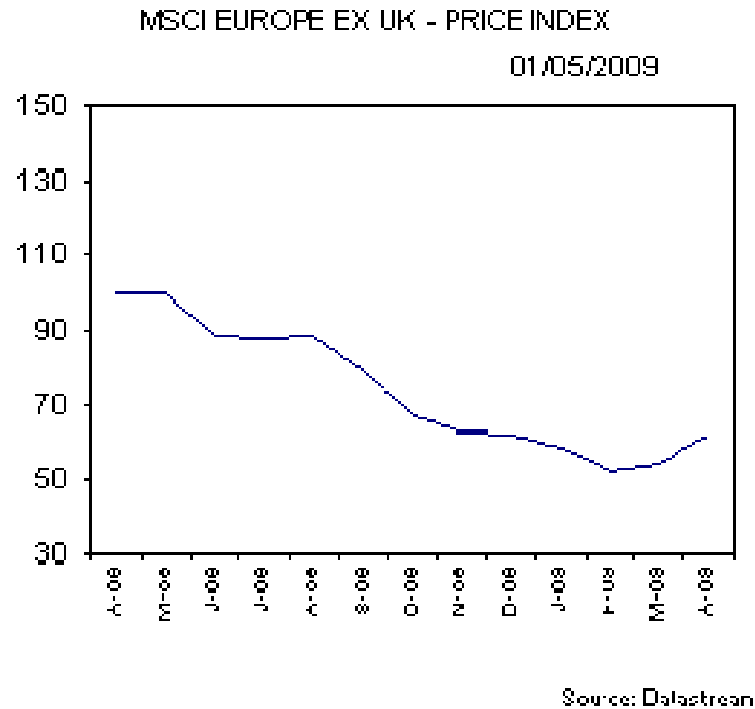
#### 5 Year Performance



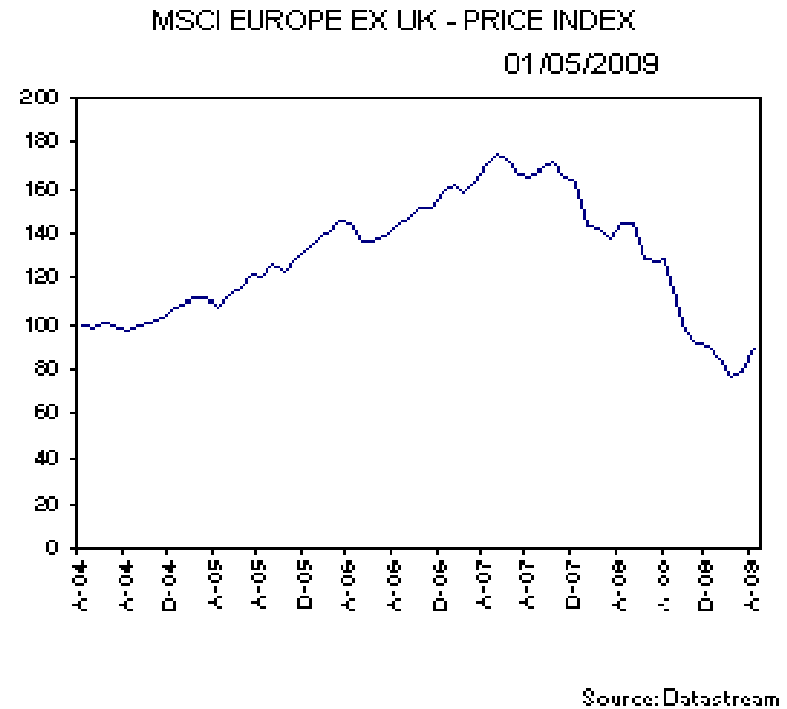
## Market Performance: Europe

The index used is the MSCI Europe (excluding UK) Index, which reflects the performance of equity markets across continental Europe, weighted according to their relative size.

### 12 Month Performance



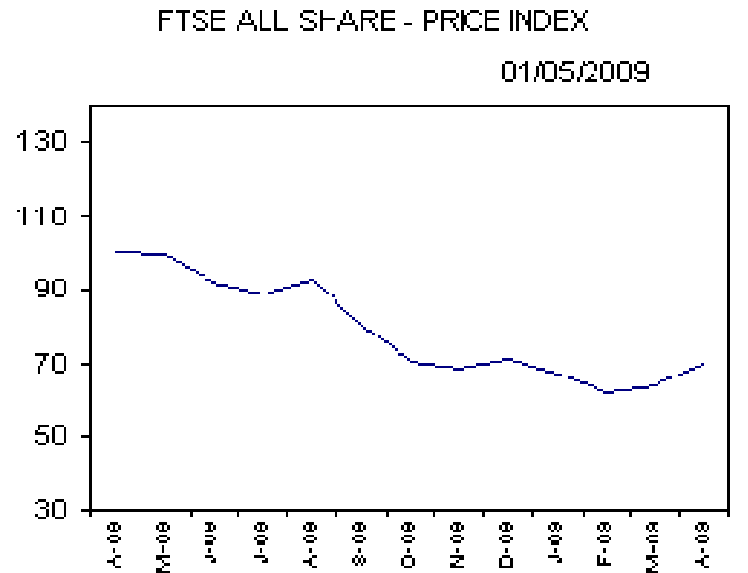

## Market Performance: UK

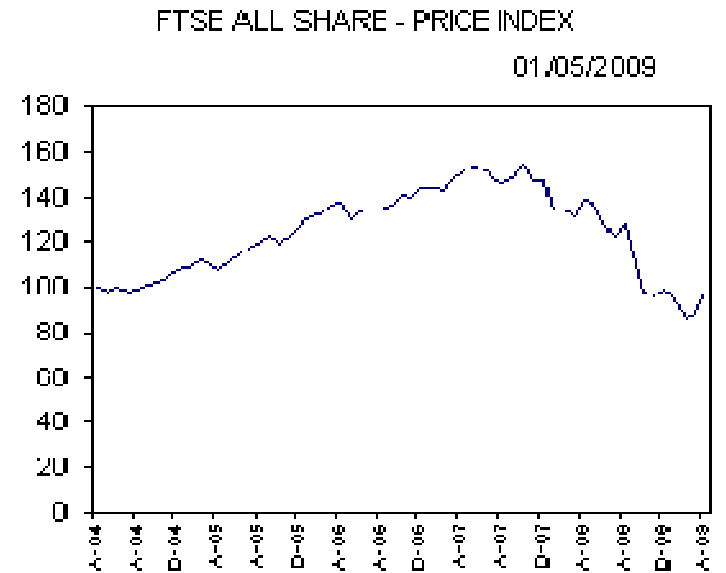
The index used is the FTSE-Actuaries All Share Index, which measures the performance of the largest quoted companies in the UK, a basket of approximately 800 companies.

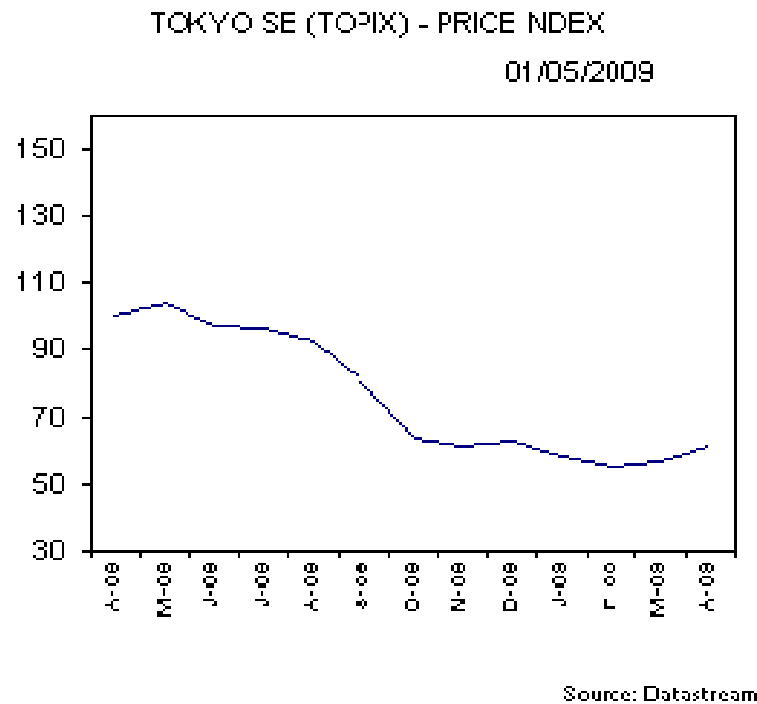

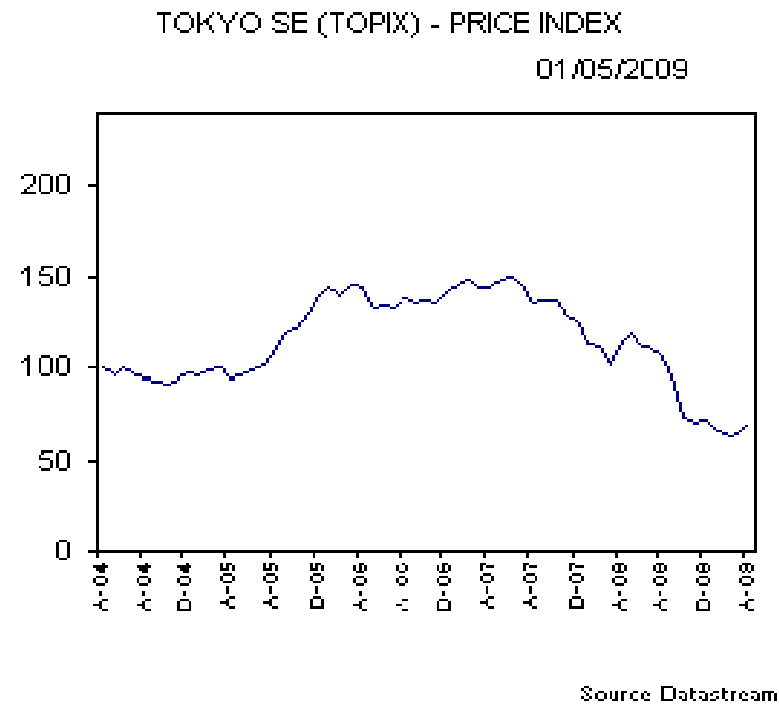
## Market Performance: Japan

The index used is the Tokyo Stock Exchange (First Section) Index, which measures the performance of Japan's largest 1,291 companies, and is widely regarded as the broad measure of the Japanese equity market.

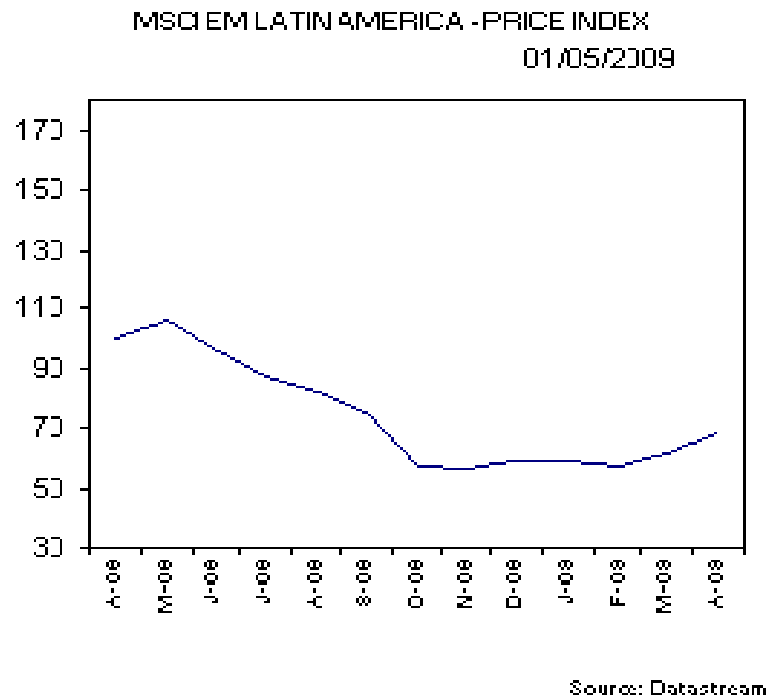
